**An Important Message for Parents of
Students Entering 7th Grade This Fall**

**New Vaccine Requirement for all
Students entering the 7th grade in the
fall of 2010**



****Students entering the 7th in the fall of 2010 will be required to
have a Tdap or Td!**

Tdap is a booster for Tetanus and pertussis (whooping cough)
Td is a booster for Tetanus, no pertussis

Cost of vaccine: \$12.00

Other vaccines recommended for adolescence:

Menactra: (for ages 2-18) protects against meningitis, cost \$12.00

HPV: (for ages 10-18) protects against human papillomavirus;
approved for males and females. This vaccine is a 3 dose series.
Cost is \$12.00 per dose, if no insurance or insurance does not pay
If private insurance covers, cost is \$200.00 per dose and payment
is made at time of vaccine. Clients must submit the receipt for
reimbursement.

Varivax: 2 doses to protect against chicken pox, if not immune
from the disease
