### Some Pfizer and Moderna recipients:

- Additional Dose: Immunocompromised people who received the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine should get an additional dose at least 28 days after their second dose.
- Booster Doses:
  - Adults age 65 and over, and those living in long-term care facilities, **should** get a booster.
  - Adults ages 50-64 at high risk of severe COVID-19 due to underlying medical conditions should get a booster.
  - Adults ages 18-49 at high risk of severe COVID-19 due to underlying medical conditions may get a booster, based on an assessment of their individual benefits and risks and consultation with their medical provider.
  - Adults age 18-64 for people whose jobs put them at high risk for COVID-19 may get a booster including health care workers, teachers, daycare staff, grocery workers, and other essential workers, along with people in shelters and prisons.
  - When: The booster dose should be administered at least six months after the second Pfizer or Moderna dose, and any available COVID-19 vaccine can be administered as a booster regardless of the primary series. A half dose of the initial Moderna vaccine will be administered for the Moderna booster.

### All Johnson & Johnson recipients:

 Those age 18 and older should get a booster at least two months after their initial shot. Any available COVID-19 vaccine (including Pfizer or Moderna) can be administered as a booster dose for Johnson & Johnson recipients.

• Does recommending boosters mean that the COVID-19 vaccines are not effective?

No, booster doses are common for many vaccines. The scientists and medical experts who developed the COVID-19 vaccines continue to closely watch for signs of waning immunity, how well the vaccines protect against new mutations of the virus, and how that data differ across age groups and risk factors. COVID vaccination continues to be the best way to keep you and our community safe from COVID-19.

# **Williams County Vaccine Providers**

There are several locations that offer COVID-19 vaccines in Williams County. Some locations require appointments and some allow walk-ins. It is recommended to call or check the provider's website for appointments or to verify walk-in clinic hours.
