Community Talking Points

May 26, 2021

- In the past 7 days (May 18th-May 25th), there have been 10 new cases, 0 hospitalizations, & 0 deaths reported. As of 5/20, Williams County remains level 2 (orange) on the Ohio Public Health Advisory System (OPHAS) and triggered 2 of the 7 indicators (New cases per capita & Non-congregate cases) and high incidence.
- Getting the COVID-19 vaccine can be convenient! Free vaccine clinics are being held at the following locations:
  - Edgerton Clinic: The WCHD is partnering with Health Partners of Western Ohio (HPWO) to host a clinic at the Edgerton Town Hall (324 N. Michigan St.) on June 3rd at 2pm - 4pm. Pfizer, Johnson & Johnson, and Moderna vaccines will be available. Pre-register by calling 567-239-4562 then click 1; walk-ins also accepted.
  - Alvordton Clinic: HPWO is planning a free clinic on June 10th from 3pm-5pm. All 3 COVID-19 vaccines will be available. Everyone 12+ is eligible. Pre-register by calling 567-239-4562 then click 1; walk-ins also accepted.
  - Montpelier WCHD Clinics: Pfizer clinics take place on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays, and J&J clinics take place on Wednesday or Fridays. Walk-in appointments are now available during clinic hours.
    - Pfizer clinics (12+): Mondays: 1:15pm - 5:15pm Tuesdays: 9:30am - 5:15pm Thursdays: 9:15am - 4:15pm
    - Johnson & Johnson clinics (18+): J&J clinic days will change each week, rotating between Wednesdays & Fridays and will take place 2pm to 4:30pm. Upcoming dates: Wed., May 26th; Fri., June 4th; Wed., June 9th; Fri., June 18th.
    - If you would like an appointment, register online (<u>bit.ly/WCVaccine</u>), by phone (419-485-3141), or by texting "VAX" to 419-630-3731.
- COVID-19 vaccines can now be administered at the same time as other vaccines.
  - Previously, it was recommended that COVID-19 vaccines be administered alone, with a minimum interval of 14 days before or after administration of any other vaccine. This recommendation was made out of an abundance of caution and has been removed based on substantial data regarding the safety of the COVID-19 vaccines currently authorized by the FDA.
  - A COVID-19 vaccine will provide similar immunity & side effects when administered alone or with other vaccines. Other vaccines can be given within the 14-day window, or on the same day as a COVID-19 vaccine.
- Governor DeWine announced Statewide Drawings for youth and adults as an extra incentive to get the COVID-19 vaccine, in addition to the health benefits.
  - All those 12-17 who have been vaccinated can enter a drawing for a full, 4-year scholarship to a State of Ohio university, including tuition, room-and-board, & books. Tonight, the first winner will be announced.
  - For those 18 and older, a separate "Ohio Vax-a-Million" drawing will take place for adults who have received at least their first dose of the vaccine to win 1 million dollars. Five winners will be chosen, beginning tonight.
  - To be eligible to be announced as a winner on a given Wednesday, Ohio residents must opt-in by the end of day the Sunday immediately prior. Official rules, FAQs, and a list of entry end dates, drawing dates, announcement dates, and a list of TV stations that will air the announcement, is available at <u>ohiovaxamillion.com</u>. The final announcement will take place on Wednesday, June 23.
  - Ohioans who would like to enter the drawings must opt-in by visiting <u>ohiovaxamillion.com</u> or by calling the ODH Call Center at 1-833-4-ASK-ODH (1-833-427-5634) between 9 a.m. and 8 p.m. daily.
