



• **COVID-19 Vaccinations Update** - While Williams County has made great progress with vaccinations, especially among older age groups, it is important for younger residents to make the decision to get the COVID-19 vaccine.





• The graph on the left shows the percentage of residents who have received the COVID-19 vaccine by age group.

 About 80% of residents 65 and older have completed the COVID-19 vaccination series.
Because the vaccination rates are so high among this age group, Williams County is seeing a shift in the average age of COVID-19 cases & hospitalizations.

• The graphs below show Williams County cases and hospitalizations by age group from the past 2 months (May 20th - July 20th). Now, cases and hospitalizations from COVID-19 are most common among residents ages 30 to 59. Earlier in the pandemic, cases and hospitalizations were most common among older age groups.



- The WCHD is hosting drive-thru back-to-school immunization clinics at local schools. These clinics will be available to make vaccines more accessible for students as they prepare for the school year.
