- Excerpt from Ohio Department of Health Fact Sheet: The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) have authorized a booster dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech/Comirnaty COVID-19 vaccine for fully vaccinated people at highest risk for serious outcomes to maximize ongoing protection against COVID-19. At this time, recipients of the Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines are not eligible for booster doses, pending ongoing evaluation. Immunocompromised individuals who meet certain, specific criteria and received an mRNA vaccine (either Pfizer or Moderna) are already eligible for a third dose at least 28 days after the second dose to strengthen the initial immune response.
 - Those currently eligible for a Pfizer/Comirnaty booster dose, at least six months following completion of their primary Pfizer series, include:
 - People 65+ years or residents in long-term care settings SHOULD receive a booster shot.
 - People ages 50 to 64 with certain underlying medical conditions SHOULD receive a booster shot.
 - People ages 18 to 49 with certain underlying medical conditions MAY receive a booster shot based on their individual benefits and risks. The CDC has indicated that this is a determination made by the vaccine recipient.
 - People ages 18 and older who are at increased risk for COVID-19 exposure and transmission because of their job or living in an institutional setting MAY receive a booster shot based on their individual benefits and risks. The CDC has indicated that this is a determination made by the vaccine recipient.
 - You are encouraged to bring your existing COVID-19 vaccine card to your booster appointment. If you
 cannot find your vaccine card, you should contact your original vaccine provider.
 - The attached table lists the vaccine providers and the type of COVID-19 vaccines offered at each location.

Paramount Advantage members do not need to take any additional action. You will receive your \$100 gift card by mail once the claim for the COVID-19 vaccine has been processed.


